

In addition to human rights, children also have special rights for children, which should be protected because they are in the course of development.

Four General Principles of the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC), commonly applied in the whole world

It's important to bear in mind these four general principles when you think about children's rights

- 1 Not to be discriminated against on any grounds.
- Consideration is given to what is best for the child.
- To have one's life protected and to grow up and develop.
- 4 To express one's views and thoughts freely.

To realize a society where each and every child and young person can be oneself, lead a happy life in the present and hope that good days continue after tomorrow as well



- Provide support for children and young people with disabilities or in need as well as single-parent families.


