Note 1 Those born between April 2, 1995 and April 1, 2007 who have not yet been vaccinated against Japanese encephalitis (total of 4 doses) can receive the unimmunized portion until before they turn 20 years old. Note 2 Women born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2009 who have received at least one dose between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2025 can receive the remaining doses for free until March 31, 2026. For more information, please call the number listed under “Enquiries” on the reverse side.

For guardians who are pregnant to those with children up to two years (Example: Born on April 20, 2023 → distributed until April 19, 2025) *Those who have not received a childrearing voucher during pregnancy or those who moved to Setagaya Ward after submitting a pregnancy notification form, or those who moved to Setagaya Ward after giving birth are also eligible for vouchers, provided they meet the above.	You will receive the voucher during the neuvola interview with a health nurse, midwife, or other health provider (interview during pregnancy/interview after birth). *You may receive postpartum advice in conjunction with child health checkups, etc. *If you would like an interview, please contact your local Health Promotion Division (refer to “3.
