**We will support your apartment rental search!**

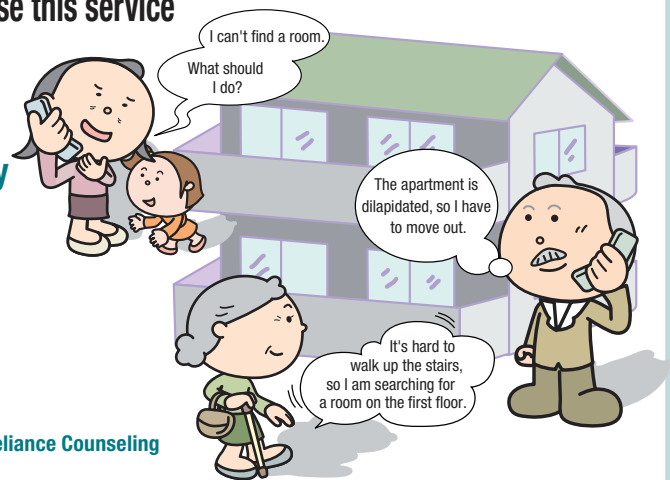
- Elderly households

With the cooperation of a real estate agency group that has signed an agreement with Setagaya City, we offer a service that provides information on available rooms in private rental housing.

● The following people who has lived in Setagaya City can use this service

- A single person 60 years of age or older, or is in a household with only elderly people
- A single person with a disability, or is in a household that includes a person with a disability
- A single-parent household with a child under 18 years of age
- An LGBTQ individuals
- In a household that includes a foreign resident (with a residence card, or other documents),
- Plathome Setagaya using households<sup>(\*)</sup>

# Flow of apartment rental search support ▶▶

## Step 1 Inquiries

### ● Inquiry for housing search

The Housing Support Center helps older persons and others who have trouble finding a room to live. Please contact us.



## Step 2 Apartment rental search

### ● Sorting out your requirements

Please tell us about your requirements for a room, such as the rent, room layout, size, and facilities you require.

### ● Provision of property information

A consultant from a real estate agency group will search for a property and will provide you with information on a property that is suitable for the elderly etc. If you cannot find the property you want, we will review the conditions and search for a new one.



### ● Preliminary inspection of rooms

If there is a property you are interested in, you can go and view it yourself.

## Step 3 Contract and moving in Two to three weeks

### ● Moving in and tenant screening

There is a tenant screening process by the real estate agency before you can move in. In some cases, you may be able to sign a contract with a guarantor company instead of a guarantor. Setagaya City also has a Guarantor Company Introduction System\*, so please consult with us first.

\*Tenant screening by a private guarantor company is required.

### ● Lease contract

The lease contract is signed by the tenant at the real estate agency. If you have any questions about signing a lease or moving out of your room, please contact us.



### ● Move out • Move in

If you have decided on a room, please contact the Housing Support Center. If you have any concerns about living in a new area, please contact us.

\* Please be sure to contact us if you cancel your reservation, change the date and time, or change the search conditions for a room.
