Head out to Keyaki Square!

Setagaya City is carrying out the Umamachi Project, meaning "equestrian city," to improve both hard and soft infrastructures of the Equestrian Park area and create a legacy of the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games. As part of this, the City hosted an outdoor event "Umamachi Plus" on August 24-25, 2019 at Keyaki Square to rediscover the charms of the area.

Setagaya City will continue to utilize Keyaki Square in a variety of ways to make the Equestrian Park area an even more attractive place for locals and visitors.


