- These clinics offer medical treatments on holidays/at night when most medical facilities will be closed.
- Treatments available for children 15 years old and younger (up to junior high school), and children with conditions with relatively mild internal medicine symptoms. (Surgical treatment, ophthalmology, and otolaryngology care are not available.) Children must be accompanied by a parent/guardian when receiving treatment. Please bring your My Number Card registered as your Health Insurance Certificate (or Health Insurance Eligibility Certificate), medical care certificate, etc., and wear a mask.
- These will be emergency treatments, so please get an examination from the family doctor after treatment. If you do not have a family doctor, medical associations, etc., will introduce you to one.
- Please be aware that these clinics stop accepting requests 30 minutes before the end of consultation hours.
- House calls are not available.
- Medicine prescriptions will only be the minimum required amount. (For a few day's supply)
- Holiday/late night pharmacies and Tamagawa Pharmacy also offer prescriptions other than those of initial treatment emergency clinics.
